A WORD FROM YOUR PASTOR

Greetings and Peace in Christ's name. We are quickly closing in on June and I have three important events to share with you. Sunday, 2 June, our confirmands will share in worship leadership at 8:45a and 11:15a. They will share with you their statement of faith they've been developing this year. Please make every effort to be in worship.

Pentecost Sunday is on 9 June 2019. What is it? Many Christians don't know why the day is special or what exactly is celebrated. It is not like Easter and Christmas that is celebrated by secular society. For those who need a quick and basic understanding of what Pentecost Sunday is about, here are 10 things you should know.

- 1. Pentecost Sunday marks the day when the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles.
- 2. Pentecost Sunday occurs 50 days after Easter.
- 3. Pentecost is recorded in Acts 2:1-13.
- 4. Pentecost comes 10 days after the Ascension of Jesus Christ.
- 5. Pentecost is also known as "the birthday of the Church".
- 6. Pentecost fulfills Jesus' promise to send the "Counselor" and "Spirit of Truth" in John 16-5-15.

- 7. Pentecost begins the large-scale spreading of the Gospel after Jesus' ascension. (Acts 2:41).
- 8. The Pentecostal movement derives its name from Acts 2.
- 9. Jews also celebrate Pentecost, but not for the same reason as Christians. The celebration by Jews of Pentecost is to observe God giving the Ten Commandments on Mount Sinai 50 days after the Exodus. The Pentecost in Jewish tradition takes place 50 days after Passover.
- 10. Pentecost is usually represented with the color red, which symbolizes the fire of the Holy Spirit.

Pentecost is June 9, also the day we celebrate the confirmation of Alexandria Fuehrer and Mariah Mattox. PLEASE NOTE we will have only <u>ONE WORSHIP at 10a</u>. This is an important day in the life of our Grace Family. Please also note that we will honor the ministry of Ed and Connie Smith. The Smiths are moving to Iowa. We intend to send them with a blessing. Again, please make every effort to be present as this is an important time in the life of our Grace Family!
