Tonight you will need Communion bread and juice, and use your own washcloth. We will end with no talking after our closing special.

We will begin with a short meditation tonight and remember our Lord's Supper. Please keep your Palm Leaf in sight so you can remember the joy of Sunday. After our Lord's Supper Table Communion, holding your washcloth for 1-3 minutes think about our meditation and this reflection: Foot-washing is a practice of radical vulnerability, of being seen and known. Jesus loved the disciples "to the very end." In this act, we remember that God holds all of our pain, vulnerability, doubts, and sufferings. As we venture toward the cross, we can lean into God's everlasting arms, knowing we are held.

As you consider Jesus washing the disciples' feet – what do you . He said: "Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash another's feet." John 13:14 Talk about the following questions: Can you wash the feet of those in your family? Are you ready to have your feet washed? If you cannot imagine washing one another's feet how about each other's hands? When you've finished, might you be able to wash one another's feet or hands now?

When washing each other perhaps you can say something like: 'As Jesus washed the disciples feet, I wash your feet as He taught.'

All share Closing Prayer: Lord Jesus, we thank our Heavenly Father, for sending You to teach us. By the power of Your Holy Spirit, fill all our hearts with a willingness to serve others. Please help us to live and give generously so that people may see Your love at work in all the lives of those who love You. For Your Jesus sake we pray. Amen.
